## SECTION I. EXTERNAL TRADE

The trade statistics refer to goods entering to all customs ports, stations, airports, and post offices in the country. The original information is obtained from the Customs Authority.

The Ethiopian Commodity Trade Classification (ECTC), based on the Standard International Trade Classification(SITC) revised, was introduced as from January 1962. In 1993, the Customs, revised its ECTC based on the Harmonized System (HS). In accordance with the Customs revision the Central Statistical Agency has also adopted the Harmonized System. This classification consists of 99 chapters, 1253 H.S headings and 5063 subheadings and 8 -digit 5330 H.S codes. Figures on foreign trade refer to year ending December 31.

Imports:- Are goods entered at the time of importation for consumption or warehousing into Ethiopia, including goods which are subsequently re-exported or re-directed.

Re-Exports:- Are imported goods subsequently re-exported without change of form, including ships' or aircraft's stores.

Exports:- Are Ethiopian products, including imports which are exported after being transformed, improved or repaired.

Coverage:-
Included are:-
All Government and non-Government transactions, goods financed by grants and loans, postal trader, bunkers' and ships' stores.

Excluded are:-
Gold, temporary imports, personal items of passengers, goods imported by diplomatic, consular Missions and cinema films.

## Valuation

a) Import - c.i.f. Ethiopian ports and customs stations, but c.i.f. - Djibouti values are accepted if so shown on the declaration. Thus, transit charges, insurance and freight charges for railway carriage between Djibouti and the border of Ethiopia are not included in values of imports using this route.
b) Exports - f.o.b. Ethiopian ports and customs stations, but goods dispatched through Djibouti are valued at f.o.b. at the Ethiopian customs station of clearance on the Ethio- Djibouti Railway and hence exclude freight, insurance and other charges from the loading station to the border.

Country of Origin:- The importers are obliged to submit manufacturer's invoices with import declarations. Generally, the country of origin is then the country in which goods were grown or produced.

Destination: - Is the country of final destination to the extent identifiable from records. Special care in this matter is given by the customs authorities to exports consigned to Djibouti and Aden.

The trade statistics published in the annual abstracts is summary figures and even the detail tables given are only up to the two digit level of the Harmonized System Trade Classification. For more detailed information, readers are referred to Annual Trade Statistics bulletin published by the Customs Authority.
